THE 23RD PSALM

The 23rd Psalm is one of the most beloved psalms ever written. Often times, though, we associate it with someone's death or a funeral service. But it has much to teach us about our relationship with God. In it the psalmist uses the personal pronoun "I", "Me", or "My" some seventeen times. In doing so he reminds us that God wants to be personal with us, the sheep of His pasture. As you read the psalm let David's personal psalm become your psalm.

If you are experiencing difficulties in your life today, remember that the Lord is your Shepherd and will provide for everything you need if you will follow Him. (See Spiritual Director... on page 2)



A Note from our Community Lay Director:

Our Living Waters Emmaus Community initiated a sponsorship program earlier this year. The program has proven to be a success from a financial standpoint. You have responded well enough for us to lower the cost of a walk from \$145. to \$100. This has been a real help to team members and pilgrims alike. In addition to lowering the cost for those on the team who are already giving their time we hoped the reduced cost would result in a larger pilgrim turnout for each walk. Our pilgrim turnout has not increased as we had hoped.

The last several walks have had eleven or twelve pilgrims. We can accommodate up to 24 pilgrims on each walk. We are leaving wonderful opportunities for the Emmaus weekend experience you were blessed with unused. for his name's sake.

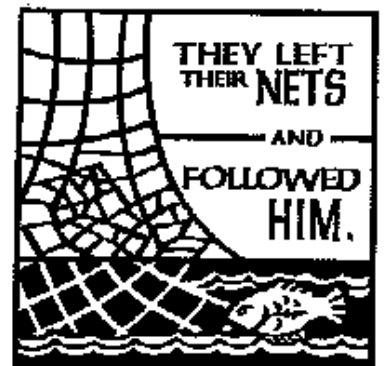
Even though I walk
