

Clean Up Committee

This committee is responsible for the restoration of the Multi-Purpose Building, Big Chapel, Bunk Houses & Staff House to their pre-Walk condition. This committee consists of 4-6 persons. Plan to arrive at the camp no later than 5:00 pm on Sunday afternoon. The scheduled time for Closing to start is 4:45 pm.

*****Note this is a separate committee from the Take Down Committee whose removal of equipment and supplies that are returned to storage should precede the work of the Clean Up Committee*****

Responsibilities of this committee:

- In the **Multi-Purpose Building** remove all posters, agape letters, miscellaneous trash from the conference room, small chapel, worship room, changing room, agape room, speaker's prayer chapel and hallway and vacuum the carpet. Empty the garbage cans. It is helpful to have large trash bags.
- Check the bathrooms (both upstairs and downstairs) – flush toilets if needed and empty the garbage cans.
- Check the kitchen and snack area – mop if necessary and empty the garbage cans.
- In the **Big Chapel** stack the chairs in the back of the room, vacuum the carpet if necessary and empty the garbage cans. (If the Humbles had time they might have done this earlier in the day)
- In the **Bunk Houses** – sweep if necessary, flush toilets if needed and empty the garbage cans. Also check the bunk house over the dining hall – flush the toilets if needed and empty the garbage cans.
- In the **Staff House** – vacuum if necessary, flush toilets if needed and empty the garbage cans.
- Do a last minute check on all rooms for anything left behind. Bring any clothing left behind to Follow Up for identification and return to owner.

All garbage can be placed in the big garbage cans located outside of each building or can be put in the garbage trailer the camp keeps parked behind the kitchen.

***** The Kitchen Committee is responsible for cleaning the kitchen area and the Closing Committee is responsible for cleaning the dining hall after Closing*****
