GOLF CART GUIDELINES

The golf carts are intended to be used primarily for transportation of the pilgrims and inside team and specifically for individuals who would have difficulty walking long distances as in the case from the multi-purpose building (conference room) to the dining hall.

Guidelines for use of the carts are:

1. Cart(s) should remain easily accessible to the pilgrims/inside team at all times. Therefore when they are in a particular building e.g. in the conference room cart(s) should remain parked near the sidewalk extending from the walkway to the multi-purpose building or if at the dining hall they should be parked immediately outside the double doors leading into the back of the dining hall.
2. Cart(s) are to be operated by individuals ages 19 and older.
3. Keys should remain in cart(s) at all times.
4. Cart(s) should never be operated at more than a moderate rate of speed.
5. Cart(s) can be used by the support team at times when they are not expected to be needed by the pilgrims and inside team. However this should be limited to periods of inclement weather e.g. rain or when needed to transport heavier equipment and supplies from one building to another.
6. Caution should be taken if a cart is in use by an outside support team member to be aware of activities of the pilgrims. Example in point is when the pilgrims are outside the conference room at their prayer stations on Saturday afternoon. All efforts should be made to minimize any distraction to the pilgrims by use of a cart by an outside team member.
7. If a situation arises that a cart is needed by the inside team but one is not available because the cart(s) are in use by an outside team member a call will be made via walkie talkie to return cart(s) to the inside team member.
